

Hackathorn Intensive 3-day Carbine & Pistol Course

June 20 – 22, 2008 - **Class description:**

This training, which consists of about 2 days of advanced tactical handgun and one day of tactical carbine instruction. Additionally, one night session of low-light instruction for both weapons will be included. Ken's classes have been met with overwhelming positive comments from students. Ken has a unique approach in his training so the idea was born to do a special class. The SEIPS ranges that will be used for this class.

Day 1

- Range fire pistol - warm up skill drills
- Advanced tactical pistol drills, point shooting/.

Day 2

- Range fire additional tactical pistol – advanced tactical skill drills
- Introduction to carbine techniques as preparation for low light session.
- Low-light drills carbine & pistol/ white light & laser shooting on the move/flashbulb technique/malfunction clearance drills.

Day 3

- Tactical carbine range drills and techniques including transition drills from pistol to carbine and carbine to pistol.
- Review of range drills and course teaching points review
- Competitions and various shoot off's, course Q&A wrap-up: wheels up from range approx. 3:30 PM heading home

Weapon/Gear Class Requirements:

Carbine:

- Serviceable duty grade carbine of minimum 5.45 / 5.56 caliber
- Serviceable tactical or assault sling- suitable for a variety of shooting drills - tactical type preferred
- Minimum of 3 serviceable carbine magazines
- Optics or Red Dot- (Not required, but highly suggested)
- Minimum 1 carbine magazine pouch - or method to carry spares magazine(s)

Handgun:

- Serviceable duty grade handgun of at least 9mm Para caliber
- Minimum of 3 serviceable pistol magazines
- Serviceable holster and magazine retention device
- Knee pads highly recommended
- Hand held white light - Visible lasers (Optional)
- Eye and ear protection (electronic hearing protection is preferred)
- Suitable range wear depending on the season (Idaho in September could be hot or cold - be prepared)
- Good attitude

Zeroed Weapons: 50-yard carbine preferred, but others are acceptable if you have a good reason why and understand it. Know your handguns zero at various ranges.

Ammo Requirements:

- 800 rounds of handgun
- 800 rounds of carbine
