

SEIPS Plate Rack Match 2012

We are planning to conduct the winter plate rack matches starting February 5, through March 11, with a make-up session March 18. The matches begin at 10:00 AM and hopefully conclude by noon. Four plate machines will be set-up in two bays, allowing us to run all four distances at the same time. This should allow us to move through the match quickly. The match is shot off-hand at four distances, 10, 15, 20, 25 yards. Each yardage is assigned a par time and six rounds are fired, reset targets, reload and another set of six rounds fired for a total of twelve rounds at each distance, 48 rounds to complete the match per gun. Cost is \$5 per gun. You can shoot as many guns as you like.

Categories will be separated by type of firearm (rifle, pistol, and revolver), optics, and caliber (rimfire, center fire). All categories will be considered as long as there are at least three competitors. Pistol caliber ammo only! Rimfire categories are not required to knock down the plates. Par times are:

10 yards = 6 seconds 15 yards = 7 seconds 20 yards = 8 seconds 25 yards = 9 seconds
